SUBJECT: **HOME VISITS BY HEALTH MANAGEMENT DIVISION**

On January 3, 2007, the Correction Captains Association disseminated a bulletin to the membership. The subject of the bulletin was "BE AWARE". This was in reference to Captains that were out sick and were violated by the Health Management Division for being out of their residence past their recreation hours. Once again, we feel it is imperative to reach out to our Captains and to remind them that HMD continues to visit our Captains while out sick. Since the bulletin that was sent to our Captains in January, several Captains have been violated by HMD for being out of their residence past the allowed recreation hours. On more than one occasion, a Captain was violated for being out of their residence for a matter of minutes. Fellow Captains, is it worth being the subject of a one week suspension for returning back to your residence a couple of minutes late?

With that said, we strongly urge all Captains to make sure that you follow the Sick Leave Directive while out sick. And if you have any concerns, please call the CCA. You also need to know that any Captains that have been charged with a sick leave violation will be afforded their day in court and will receive representation from this union and our attorneys.

P.S. On another note, Captain Anastasia Henderson will be in court on September 18th 2007 in Bronx Supreme at 9:30am in Part 60 on the 4th floor. Also, Captain Sherman Graham will be in court on September 28, 2007 in Bronx Supreme Court at 9:30am in Part 60 on the 4th floor.
