Dear Captain:


We have received reports that members of the Inspector General's Office have appeared at Captains' homes unannounced seeking to have "an informal friendly conversation". While this has happened in the past, it is now occurring with increasing frequency.

These people are **not** your friend and have no interest in a friendly conversation. While these actions may not be illegal, we do not believe this is the proper way to conduct business. Appearing at someone's doorstep unannounced in the early morning hours is not only inconsiderate, but offensive and disrespectful to us as Captains and the job we do.

The CCA reminds you that you have a constitutional right to legal representation prior to answering any questions by members of the Inspector General's Office or any investigative body.
