On Wednesday, September 28, 2022 at 1100 hours, there will be a hearing at the City Council concerning a proposed Bill that will ban the Correction Department from operating a punitive segregation unit within our jails. There is no need for me to tell you this proposed bill is dangerous to the safety and security of everyone who are behind the gate – Captain, Correction Officers, civilian staff and inmates alike. You live it every single day you are at work.

What I am asking you to do is make your voice heard and tell these elected officials just how dangerous and reckless this bill is. We encourage all of you if you are not at work, come to the city council hearing and make your voice heard. We need all the support we can get to try and convince the council members just how reckless implementing this proposal is. We have said it before and we will say it again – come do the job we do, even for one tour, and let's see what your opinion is.


